Maurizio Malvestiti**, ad interim Regent for Northern Italy, **Governor General Leonardo Visconti di Modrone** and **Lieutenant General Agostino Borromeo** welcomed the many friends who came to celebrate the feast of the Patroness of the Order of the Holy Sepulchre, chief among them Vatican Secretary of State, **Cardinal Pietro Parolin**.

Like every year, the reception was an opportunity to exchange experiences and promote greater awareness about the life of the Order. In particular, Rome based friends of the Order were able to experience the internationality of our Pontifical institution, thanks to the presence of the heads of the various Lieutenancies.
